

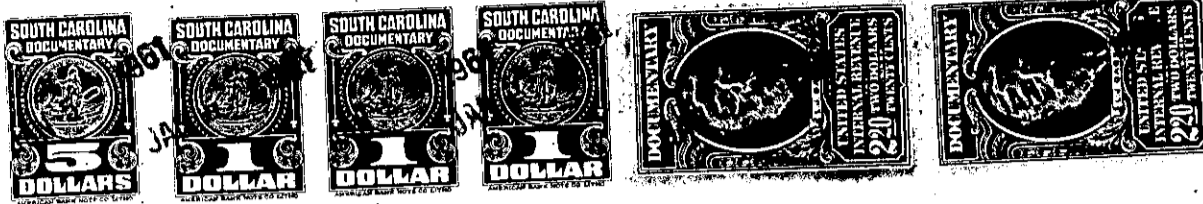

PHYLLIS L. HERRING and JAMES W. HERRING, their heirs and assigns, forever:

ALL that lot of land situate on the South and East side of Windfield Road, in the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, S. C., being shown as Lot No. 2 on plat of Windfield Heights, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, April 1955, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book EE, page 102, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of Windfield Road, at joint front corner of Lots 1 and 2, running thence along the line of Lot 1, N. 70-44 E. 290.1 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 16-54 W. 175.6 feet to an iron pin on the South side of Windfield Road; thence with the South side of Windfield Road, S. 69-43 W. 224.2 feet to an iron pin; thence with the curve of Windfield Road (the chord being S. 27-30 W. 88.8 feet) to an iron pin on the East side of Windfield Road; thence along the East side of Windfield Road, S. 14-44 E. 111.3 feet to the beginning corner.

This is a portion of the property conveyed to the grantor by deed of M. B. Crigler dated May 3, 1955, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Deed Book 530, page 166.
