

THIS DEED, made this 2nd day of February
 in the year one thousand nine hundred and sixty-one (1961)
 by METROPOLITAN LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY
 under the laws of the State of New York, of the City, County
 and State of New York,

WITNESSETH, that in consideration of the sum of Five
 Dollars (\$5.00) and other valuable consideration said
 METROPOLITAN LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY does grant and convey unto

LESTER H. THOMPSON, as Acting
 Federal Housing Commissioner, his successors and assigns, in
 fee simple, all that lot or parcel of land situate, lying and
 being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina,
 and more particularly described as follows:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings
 and improvements thereon, situate on the west side of
 Crosby Circle, near the City of Greenville, in Greenville
 County, S. C., being shown as Lot 211 on plat of Para-
 mount Park, made by Piedmont Engineering Service, July
 1949, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville
 County, S. C., in Plat Book W, at Page 57, said lot
 fronting 101.5 feet along the west side of Crosby
 Circle, running back to a depth of 160 feet on the north
 side, to a depth of 160.1 feet on the south side and
 being 20.1 feet across the rear.

 and premises above described and mentioned, and hereby intended
 to be conveyed, together with the rights, privileges, appurten-
 ances and advantages thereto belonging or appertaining, unto
 *as acting Federal Housing Commissioner,
 and to the proper use of the said LESTER H. THOMPSON; his
 successors and assigns, in fee simple.

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
