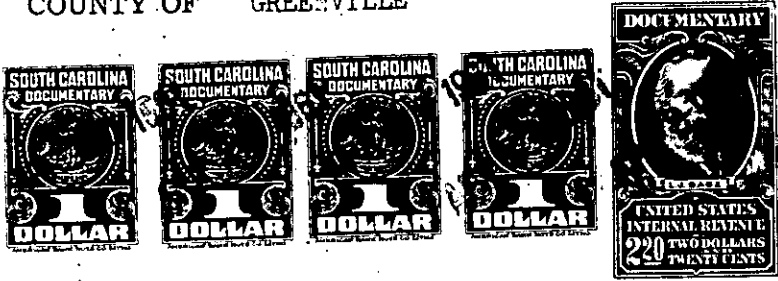

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That I, Mrs. Jeanne D. Threatt

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars and No Cents, -(\$1700.00)-----Dollars

to Me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Joseph Robinson and Catherine Robinson

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Joseph Robinson and Catherine Robinson

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot No. Thirteen (13) on plat of Ghana Drive, made by J. C. Hill, R. L. S., November 23rd, 1959, and recorded in the Register of Mesne Conveyance Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 00, Page 377 and having, according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Ghana Drive, to the easterly side of Blassengame Road, proceeding S. 18-E. 35.9 Feet, 54.1 Feet along said Ghana Drive to an iron pin; thence N. 62-E. 150 Feet along the line of Lot No. Twelve (12) to an iron pin; thence N. 36-W. 107.4 Feet along the rear line of the Greater Greenville Sewerage N. 25 Feet right of way; thence N. 69-50 E. 150 Feet along the line of Lot No. Fourteen (14), to Ghana Drive, the point of beginning.
