ALL that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Butler Township, Greenville County, Greenville County, South Carolina, lying on the North side of the Woodruff-Greenville Highway (Anderson Bridge Road) being a portion of a tract known as property of Harry L. Sloan Estate, according to a plat recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "O", page 19, the tract herein described contains approximately $1\frac{1}{2}$ acres, more or less, and has the following description:

BEGINNING at a nail in the center of the Woodruff-Greenville Highway, corner of property now or formerly of H. O.
