I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, Rosa J. Owens and Emma J. Nix, Individually and as  
Administratrices of the Estate of Cary Sue Jordan, Deceased,

on or about the 7th day of November in the year of  
our Lord nineteen hundred and fifty-two exhibited their  
complaint in the County Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against  
Addie Jordan Hannon, et al,

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to  
be heard on the 20th day of April 1953,  
and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged  
and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN,  
Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Quincy Davenport  
for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear;

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County  
of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release  
unto the said Quincy Davenport

"All that piece, parcel or lot of land situated, lying and being  
in Oaklawn Township, County and State aforesaid, and more fully described  
as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on line of Alverson's land and running thence  
N. 65-30 W. 1555 feet to a stake; thence S. 29-40 W. 350 feet to a stake;  
thence S. 65-30 E. 1200 feet to a stake; thence N. 72-25 E. 503 feet to  
the beginning corner, containing ten acres, more or less, and being the same  
property conveyed to Cary Sue Jordan by deed of G. C. Jordan, et al, re-  
corded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 235, at Page  
123."

The consideration for the above conveyance was \$100.00 which was  
paid direct to the Plaintiffs by the grantee herein as provided for in  
the Decree of Court in this case.
