CHARTER

BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS,

W. J. NEWHOUSE and HARRIET N. NEWHOUSE

both of

707 Pine Creek Drive, Greenville, South Carolina

MAY 23 10 03 AM 1962

did on the 5th day of June, 1961, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration, signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is W. J. NEWHOUSE & SONS, INC.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is 707 Pine Creek Drive, Greenville, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is distribute first aid and safety supplies and equipment and related products and to enter into such other lines of endeavor as deemed to the best interest of the corporation.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00)----- Dollars payable in cash, goods or services

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is Ten Thousand (10,000) of the par value of One (\$1.00)----- Dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 19th day of May, 1961, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors:

W. J. Newhouse and Harriet N. Hewhouse

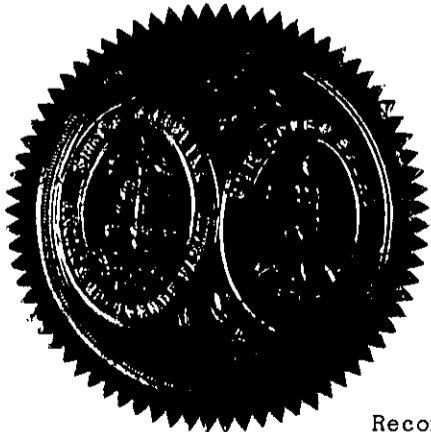
EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, W. J. Newhouse ; as Vice-President, Harriet N. Newhouse ; as Secretary, Harriet N. Newhouse ; as Treasurer, W. J. Newhouse

NINTH: That all requirements of Title 12, Article 1, Chapter 2, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in the Greenville Piedmont

a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
