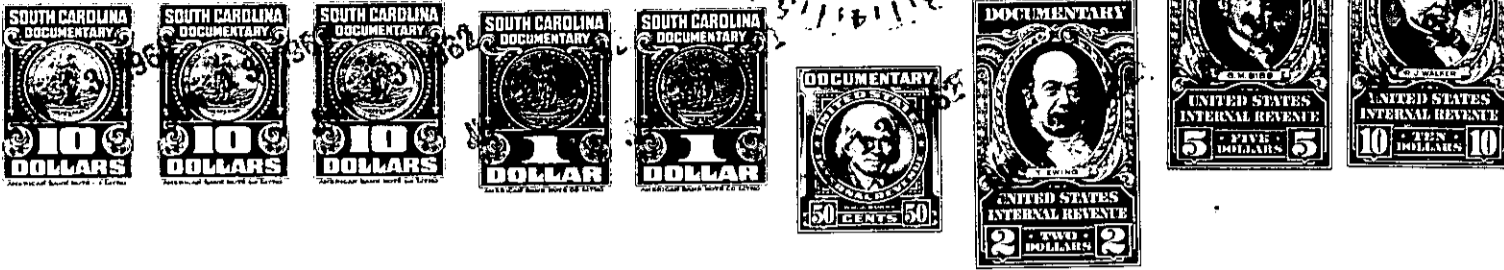
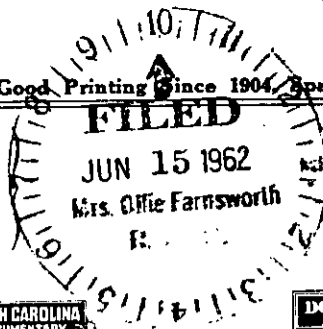

All that certain tract or parcel of land in Glassy Mountain Township County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lots Nos. 1097, 1098, and 1099 of the Lake Lanier Subdivision, as more fully shown on Plat of said property made by George Kershaw for the Tryon Development Co. and duly recorded in Plat Book G at page 35, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C.

This being the same property conveyed to J. S. Paget by G. L. Hughes, deed dated March 20, 1952 and recorded in Deed Book 453 at page 261, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County and also being the same property conveyed by the said J. S. Paget to George A. Harley by deed dated and recorded in Deed Book at page R.M.C.
