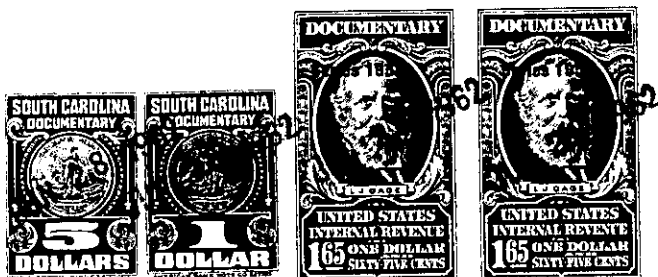

M. C. Office for Greenville County. Being a part of the same property conveyed to me by deed of Blanche S. Bostick, dated June 23, 1961, and being all of the same property conveyed to Frank J. Bostick and N. J. Babb by M. L. Ashmore as Tax Collector, recorded in Deed Book 208 at page 196. See also Deed Book 219, page 281. This being a portion of the property devised to Blanche S. Bostick under the terms of the will of Frank J. Bostick, deceased, and being a portion of the property conveyed to Blanche S. Bostick by deed of LeRoy Moore, Master for Spartanburg County, dated February 7, 1961, and recorded in Deed Book 671, page 84, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, and which said deed is also recorded in Deed Book 26-T, page 311, R.M.C. Office for Spartanburg County. Said property is bounded by Lake Lanier, the hard surface road running around Lake Lanier, other property of Grantor and by other property of Grantee, being bounded on the North by Lot No. 1031
