Thirty Five & No/100 (\$ 35.00) Dollars

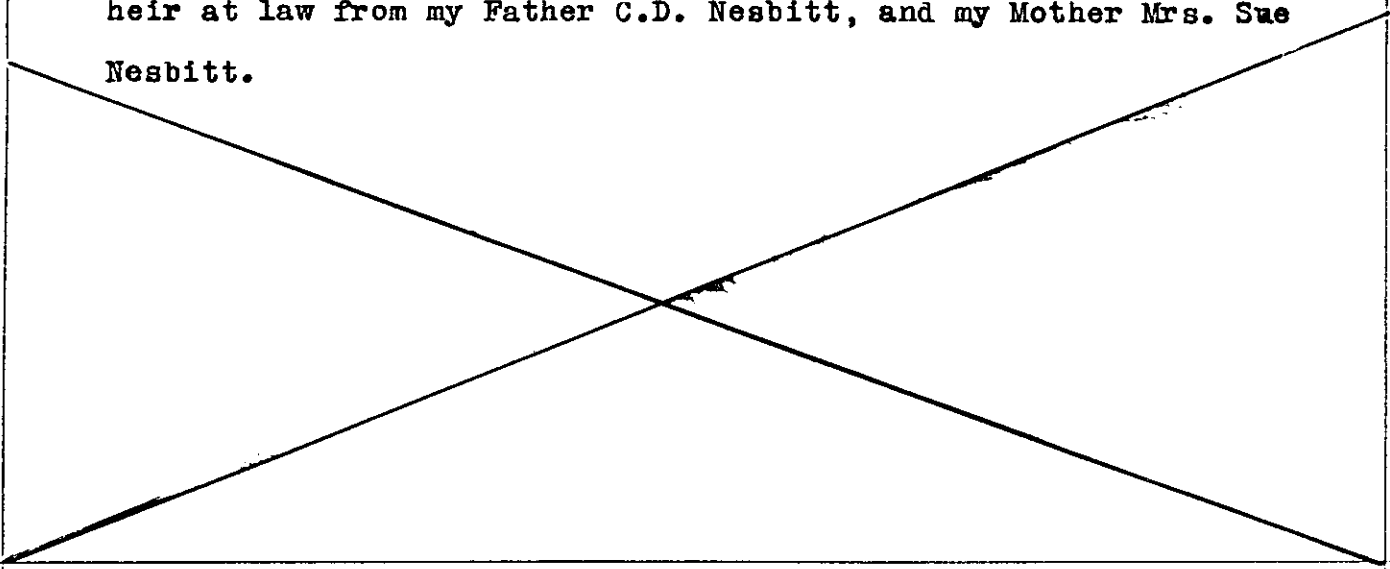
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents

these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said S.A. Nesbitt, and
Sue T Cleveland, ; their heirs and assigns forever;

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Grove Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina ; " Begining in center of Oil Mill road

on corner of Mrs. Pearl Young, on Trowbridge line 18 feet 8 inches
from center of Red oak stump on North side, 26-1/2 feet from
Hickory on South side, thence with Trowbridge line North 67- 35
West, 3 chains ^{11.20} 20 links to a iron pin, thence N 10-20 W ^{161.04} 2.44 chains
to an iron pin in Oil Mill road at Corner Golden Grove Church
lot, thence with Oil Mill road ^{324.72} 4.92 chains to the begining corner.
Containing Thirty Two- one hunderth (32/100) of one acre, more
or less, as the suvey of R.E. Dalton, C.E. Oct. 1923.
