An undivided one-half interest in all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with all improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Chick Springs Township, on the Southeast side of Wade Hampton Boulevard, and being known and designated as Lot No. 1 of a subdivision of the property of Betty R. DeMint as Wildair Estates as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book EE, page 19, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
