ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying at the Southwestern corner of the intersection of Batson Drive and Haynsworth Road, shown and designated as LOT NO. 4 on a plat entitled "Property of Ralph McIntosh", recorded in the rmc Office for Greenville County in Plat Book AA, at page 79 and also being a portion of Lot 31 on plat of Farr Estates, recorded in the rmc Office for Greenville County in Plat Book M, at page 19 and being further described as follows;
