

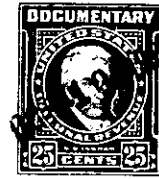
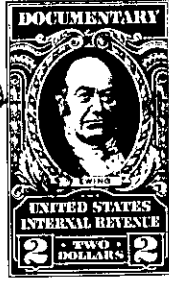
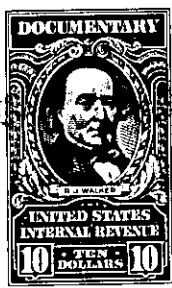

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That We, Troy D. Vaughn, Joe Wilson Vaughn, Hazel V. Chandler, Frances V. Stokes, Nellie Mae R. Vaughn, and Annie V. Cannada,

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Seventeen Thousand and Four Hundred (\$17,400.00) - - - - - Dollars

to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents

by Louis J. Vaughn

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain, sell and release unto the said Louis J. Vaughn and his heirs and assigns forever:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, lying on the Taylor Road, sometimes known as Ballenger Road, about one-half mile north of the City of Greer, having the following courses and distances:

BEGINNING at a stake on said road, and runs thence with said road, N. 15-45 E. 6.95 chains to a turn; thence N. 24-15 E. 2.34 chains to a turn; thence N. 7-30 E. 7.00 chains to an iron pin; thence N. 28 E. 2.39 chains to an iron pin; thence N. 17 W. 6.15 chains to a stake; thence N. 81 W. 7.59 chains to an iron pin; thence S. 1-30 E. 3.90 chains to a stone; thence N. 84-15 W. 12.65 chains to a stone; thence S. 2 E. 11.80 chains to a stone; thence N. 73-30 E. 7.34 chains to a stone; thence S. 24-30 E. 6.90 chains to a stone; thence S. 1 W. 1.83 chains to a stone; thence S. 9-45 E. 3.44 chains to a stone; thence S. 75 E. 3.18 chains to a stone; thence S. 84-15 E. 4.47 chains to the beginning, containing 29 acres, more or less. EXCLUDING, HOWEVER, from the above boundaries parcels or lots of land heretofore conveyed therefrom.

Bounded by lands of E.R. Taylor on the north, east and west, and on the south by lands of S.W. Taylor and Belmont Heights, Inc.
