named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto OTIS P. MOORE, his heirs and assigns,
forever:

ALL the grantors two-thirds interest in and to all those lots of land
situate near the Town of Mauldin, in Greenville County, South Carolina,
being shown as Lot Nos. 1, 4, 7, 10, 13, 16, 19, 22, 25, 28, 31, 34, 37,
40, 43, 46, 49, 52, 55, 58, 61, 70, 73, 76, 79, 82, 85, 88, 91, 94, 97;
as shown on plat of Windsor Park, made by R.K. Campbell, Surveyor, March
1960, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S.C. in Plat
Book RR, Page 25, said lots having such metes, bounds, courses and distances
as are shown on said plat.

The grantors by their deed recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville
County, S.C. in Deed Book 649, Page 446, conveyed the above described lots
to the grantee herein but through error referred to the interest conveyed
as being an undivided one-third interest. It was intended by that deed
to convey all of the interest which the grantors had in said lots which
was an undivided two-thirds interest. Therefore the purpose of this deed
is to correctly describe the interest being transferred from the grantors
to the grantee in the lots above described.
