NOW, THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Colonial Pipeline Company, a Delaware corporation, duly domesticated in the State of South Carolina, for and in consideration of the premises and \$1.00 to it in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Marvin C. Woodson (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold, quitclaimed and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, quitclaim and release unto the said Marvin C. Woodson, his heirs and assigns forever:

All of the rights, title and interest conveyed to Colonial Pipeline Company by Marvin C. Woodson in and by that certain right of way easement from Marvin C. Woodson to Colonial Pipeline Company dated July 3, 1962, and recorded August 11, 1962, in Deed Book 704 at pages 222 and 223, and as more particularly shown on plat attached to said right of way easement and recorded in Deed Book 704 at page 224, all in the R.M.C. Office of Greenville County, South Carolina.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident
