CHARTER
BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS,

J. S. Paget, L. B. Wilson and W. J. Gibson,
all of Greer, S.C.,

did on the 8th. day of July, 1942, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration,
signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is C. & D. CHEVROLET COMPANY

THIRD: That the principal place of business is GREER, S.C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to engage in the business
of purchasing new and used automobiles and selling same, together with pur-
chasing and selling automobile accessories and parts, and also operating
repair shop and garage.

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SOUTH CAROLINA

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Fourteen Thousand (\$14,000.00)----- Dollars,
payable Seven Thousand (\$7,000.00) Dollars of which is subscribed and is to be paid
in cash, or its equivalent in property, upon perfection of the corporation.

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is One Hundred and Forty (140)
of the par value of One Hundred (\$100.00)----- Dollars.

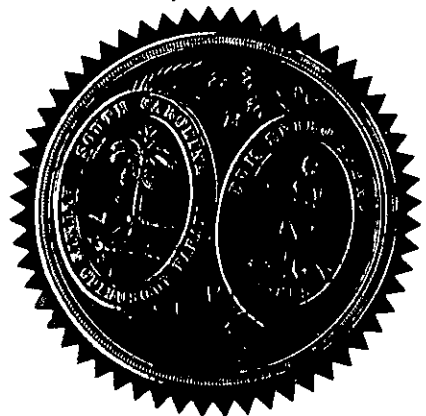
SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 7th. day of
July, 1942, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the follow-
ing were elected directors:
J. S. Paget, L. B. Wilson and W. J. Gibson.

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, J. S. Paget ;
as Vice-President L. B. Wilson ; as Secretary, W. J. Gibson ;
as Treasurer, W. J. Gibson.

NINTH: That all requirements of Article 2, Chapter 153, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1932, and all amendments
thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by
bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice
of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in Greer Citizen,
a newspaper published in the County of Greenville.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, W. P. BLACKWELL, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the afore-
said Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of
South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to
commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the
Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
