ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, on the Coleman Road, adjoining lands now or formerly of C. Douglas Wilson and having, according to a survey made by Terry T. Dill, surveyor, October 13, 1956, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the E/S of Coleman Road, joint corners this land and that of C. Douglas Wilson and running with said road, N. 53-25 W. 416.4 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 34-10 E. 490.5 feet to the Wilson line; thence with said line, S. 33-00 W., 247.5 feet to the beginning corner.
