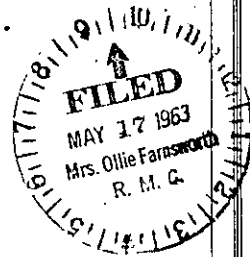

WHEREAS, **Farrell E. Runyan, Route 3, Box 355, Travelers Rest, S. C.**  
 and  
**Nolen L. Brunson, Box 987, Rock Hill, S. C.**



two or more of the officers or agents appointed to supervise or manage the affairs of

**RUNYAN EVANGELISTIC ASSOCIATION**

which has been duly and regularly organized, did on the **30th** day of **April**, A. D. 1963, file with the Secretary of State a written declaration setting forth:

That, at a meeting of the aforesaid organization held pursuant to the by-laws or regulations of the said organization, they were authorized and directed to apply for incorporation.

That, the said organization holds, or desires to hold, property in common for Religious, Educational, Social, Fraternal, Charitable or other eleemosynary purpose, or any two or more of said purposes, and is not organized for the purpose of profit or gain to the members, otherwise than is above stated, nor for the insurance of life, health, accident or property; and that three days' notice in the **Greenville News**, a newspaper published in the County of **Greenville**, has been given that the aforesaid Declaration would be filed.

AND WHEREAS, Said Declarants and Petitioners further declared and affirmed:

FIRST: Their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: The name of the proposed Corporation is **RUNYAN EVANGELISTIC ASSOCIATION**

THIRD: The place at which it proposes to have its headquarters or be located is **Greenville, S. C.**

FOURTH: The purpose of the said proposed Corporation is to operate exclusively for religious purposes, to seek the salvation of the lost at home and abroad, to conduct Christian religious services, to study and proclaim principles of Christian living as taught in the Holy Bible, to provide opportunities to its members for Christian service, and to proclaim the gospel of Jesus Christ throughout the world through every possible means. In the event of dissolution, the residual assets will be turned over to another organization which is itself exempt from federal income tax, under Sec. 501 (c)(3), of the Internal Revenue Code, or to the federal, state, or local government.

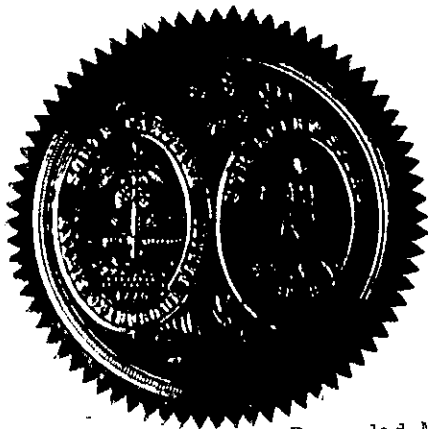

FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested, by Chapter 12, Title 12, Code of 1952, and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby declare the said organization to be a body politic and corporate, with all the rights, powers, privileges and immunities, and subject to all the limitations and liabilities, conferred by said Chapter 12, Title 12, Code of 1952, and Acts amendatory thereto.

GIVEN under my hand and the seal of the State, at Columbia, this **30th** day of **April** in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and **63** and in the one hundred and **87th** year of the Independence of the United States of America.
