KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That THE COUNTY OF GREENVILLE  
a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina  
and having its principal place of business at Greenville  
in the State of South Carolina , for and in consideration of the

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee(s) hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto ALETHEA FENNEL PATE, her heirs and assigns, forever:

ALL the right, title and interest of the County of Greenville in and to that strip of land near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, S. C., approximately 50 feet in width and extending in a Northeasterly direction from a point near the intersection of Pelham Road and Roper Mountain Road to a point on the Southwest side of the right of way of Interstate Highway I-385, said strip being 2,363.4 feet in length and being what was formerly a part of Airport Road.

This strip of land has now been abandoned as a public road and the grantee herein is an owner of the property on both sides of the road.
