KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, John G. Wilson and Barbara C. Wilson, of Greenville County

in consideration of One Thousand, Four Hundred Fifty and no/100 . . . (\$1,450.00) . . . . . Dollars, and assumption of mortgage hereinafter mentioned the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto John N. Castrinos, and Callie S. Castrinos, their heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Chick Springs Township, being known and designated as Lot No. 104 of a subdivision known as Orchard Acres, Section Two, as shown on a plat of a portion of said subdivision prepared by J. Mac Richardson, Surveyor, March 1960, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book QQ, at Page 6, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern edge of Ridge Spring Street, joint front corner of Lots 103 and 104, and running thence along the joint line of said lots, S. 4-24 E. 175 feet to an iron pin on the rear line of Lot No. 119; thence along the line of that lot, N. 85-36 E. 49 feet to an iron pin, the joint rear corner of Lots 119 and 118; thence along the rear line of Lot 118, S. 85-45 E. 41.1 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot 105; thence along the line of that lot, N. 4-24 W. 181.2 feet to an iron pin on the southern edge of Ridge Spring Street; thence along the southern edge of Ridge Spring Street, S. 85-36 W. 90 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner; being the same conveyed to us by Larry G. Shaw by his deed dated August 14, 1963.

As a part of the consideration for this conveyance, the grantee expressly assumes and agrees to pay the balance due on that certain note and mortgage in the original sum of \$15,000.00 executed by the grantors to the First Federal Savings and Loan Association of Greenville and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Mortgage Book 932, at Page 301, the balance due thereon being the sum of \$14,928.93 as of this date.
