Beginning at a stone running S. E. to a stone; thence following an old road to a black gum; thence N. W. to head of a spring; thence with spring branch to beginning corner, containing twenty-five (25) acres more or less. Bounded by lands now or formerly of Bridgeman and others.

Tract No. 2, having the following metes and bounds, beginning at a stone on a branch; thence with Wiborn towards line to the Wheeler Hickory corner of Howards and R. E.
