All that piece, parcel or lot of land with buildings thereon in Grove Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the Town of Piedmont and East of the Greenville and Columbia Railway, designated as Lot number Three (3) of the O. W. Stewart land on a plat made by Frank Adkins, Surveyor, dated March, 1950; the lot herein described lies on the East side of the old Greenville and Pelzer road and has the following courses and distances to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of the Old Greenville-Pelzer road, joint corner of Lot No. 2, thence along the line of Lot number 2, N. $71\frac{1}{2}$ E. 382.8 feet to iron pin; thence N. $28\text{-}\frac{3}{4}$ W. 113.5 feet to iron pin, joint corner of Lot number 4; thence along line of Lot number 4 to iron pin on East side of said road; thence along side of road S. $28\text{-}\frac{3}{4}$ E. 113.5 feet to the beginning corner, containing one acre (1) more or less, bounded on the North by Lot number 4, on the East by land of O.
