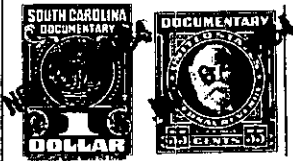

Know all Men by these Presents, That I, Flora McClimons

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and re-leased, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Myrl Greene and her heirs and assigns forever:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chicks Springs Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, just South from the Town of Greer, and fronting on the New Pelham Road, having the following courses and distances, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on edge of New Pelham Road at Southwest corner of Myrl Greene's lot, and runs thence S. 82.20 E. 5.90^{3/4} chains to an iron pin on ditch; thence S. 7 E. 86^{1/2} linksto an iron pin on ditch; thence N. 82.20 W. 6^{3/4} chains to an iron pin on edge of New Pelham Road; thence N. $\frac{1}{2}$ E. with said New Pelham Road to the beginning corner, containing one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) Acre, more or less, according to a survey by M.O. Owens, Surveyor, January 10, 1935, and known as lot No. 4 on a plat of the said survey.

This is the identical lot of land conveyed to me, the grantor, by Cleo Holtzclaw, et al., by deed dated February 1, 1935, said deed not recorded.
