All those certain pieces, parcels or lots of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot Nos. 25, 39, 40 and 67 of Washington Heights Subdivision on a plat made by C. M. Furman, Jr., February 3, 1922, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book F at Page 54, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

LOT NO. 25: BEGINNING at a point on the north side of Lafayette Street at the joint front corner of Lots 25 and 26, and running thence with the joint line of said lots N. 46-35 E. 100 feet to the joint rear corner of Lots 25 and 26; thence along the rear line of Lot 25, S. 43-25 E. 35 feet to the joint rear corner of Lots 24 and 25; thence running with the joint line of said lots S. 46-35 W. 100 feet to a point on the north side of Lafayette Street; thence along Lafayette Street N. 43-25 W. 35 feet to the point of beginning, being the same property conveyed to Fannie C. Norwood by E. Inman, Master, by deed recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 139 at Page 166.

LOT NO. 39: BEGINNING at a point on the southwestern side of Lincoln Street, being approximately thirty-five (35) feet from the southwestern corner of Lincoln Street and McLeod Street, at the joint front corner of Lots 38 and 39, and running thence with the joint line of said lots, S. 46-35 W. 100 feet to the joint rear corner of Lots 38 and 39; thence along the rear line of Lot 39, S. 43-25 E. 35 feet to a point on the northwestern side of McLeod Street; thence along McLeod Street N. 46-35 E., 100 feet to a point on the southwestern side of Lincoln Street; thence along Lincoln Street N. 43-25 W. 35 feet to the point of beginning, being the same property conveyed to Fannie C. Norwood by E. Inman, Master
