"All that parcel or lot of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, on the South side of Pleasant Ridge Avenue and being known and designated as Lot No. 122 of Pleasant Valley as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "P", at Page 92, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:
