in consideration of Two Thousand Two Hundred (\$2,200.00) and assumption of Mtg. Dollars,

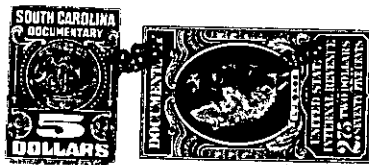

ALL that piece, parcel, or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Northeastern side of Vanderbilt Circle, and being known and designated as Lot No. 82 on a plat of White Oaks Subdivision recorded in the Office of the RMC for Greenville County in Plat Book P, pages 120 and 121, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northeastern side of Vanderbilt Circle at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 81 and 82 and thence running along Vanderbilt Circle, N. 25-06 W. 95 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 77-28 E. 262.3 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 4-56 E. 40 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 64-24 W. 240.3 feet to the point of beginning.
