

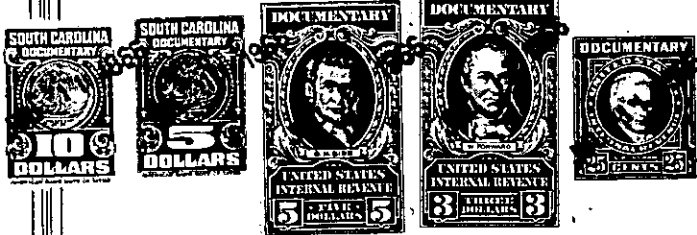

Village of Taylors, and having the approximate measures to-wit:
