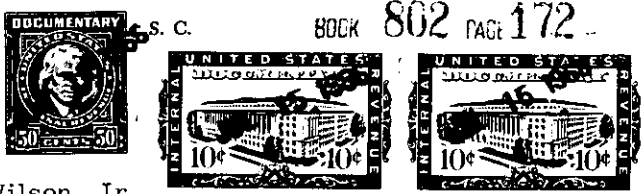

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Stanyarn V. Wilson, Jr.,

in consideration of Thirteen Thousand Twenty-Five and No/100 (\$13,025.00)----- Dollars,
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto

Robert D. Nelson and Barbara K. Nelson, their heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, City of Greenville, on the eastern side of Legrand Boulevard and being known and designated as Lot No. 11 on plat of Sherwood Forest Subdivision, said plat being recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "BB", at Pages 30 and 31 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of Legrand Boulevard, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 11 and 12 and running thence with the common line of said lots N. 88-30 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence with the rear line of Lot No. 11 S. 1-30 E. 74 feet to an iron pin; thence with the common line of Lots Nos. 10 and 11 S. 88-30 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on the eastern side of Legrand Boulevard; thence with the eastern side of said Boulevard N. 1-30 W. 74 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.

The above is the same property conveyed to the grantor by deed dated August 26, 1952 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 461, at Page 449.
