All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, lying and being on the westerly side of Riverside Drive, in the City of Greenville, S. C., being known and designated as Lots 15, 16, 17 and 18 on plat of Marshall Forest, as recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book H, at pages 133 and 134 and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the westerly side of Riverside Drive, said pin being the joint front corner of Lots 18 and 19 and running thence with the common line of said Lots S 80-05 W 252.4 feet to an iron pin on the northeasterly side of a ten foot alley reserved for pipes and poles; thence with the northeasterly side of said alley reserved for pipes and poles N 41-40 W 144.3 feet to an iron pin on the southerly side of a ten foot alley reserved for pipes and poles; thence with the southerly side of said alley reserved for pipes and poles N 85-20 E 406.9 feet to an iron pin on the westerly side of Riverside Drive; thence with the westerly side of Riverside Drive S 41-39 W 58.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S 22-20 W 58.4 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.

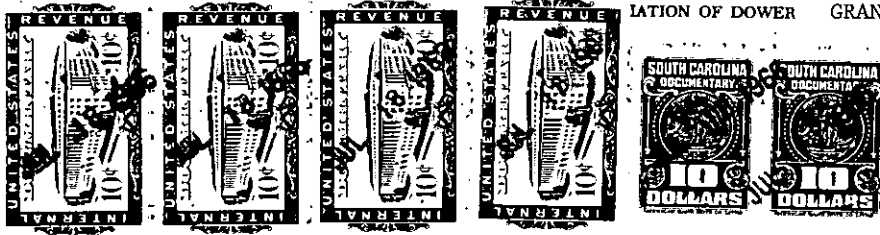
