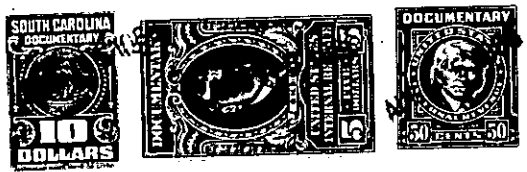
KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Mrs. Mae Cox Locke, of Greenville County
