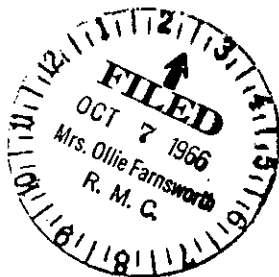

All that piece, parcel or lot of land lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, on the eastern side of Rowley Street in the first block north of Park Avenue in the City of Greenville and being known as Number 10 Rowley Street. The said lot is designated as Lot No. 2 in a resurvey of the City made for D. B. Traxler Agent by W. D. Neves, Engineer, and is the same lot conveyed to C. F. Putman by Mrs. S. A. Taylor by deed dated January 16, 1945, recorded in Deed Book 271, page 160. The said lot begins at an iron pin on Rowley Street and runs thence S. 76-30 E. 166.8 feet along Lot No. 1; thence N. 30-30 E. 52 feet to Lot No. 3; thence N. 76-30 W. 176.6 feet along Lot No. 3 to Rowley Street; thence along Rowley Street S. 20-10 W. 50 feet to the beginning.

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
