George B. Wilbanks and Lola Mae Wilbanks, their Heirs and Assigns forever;

All that certain piece, parcel or strip of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, Oneal Township, in the Gilreath Mill Community, lying on the west side of the Valley Lane Road and on the south side of a small spring branch, and being triangular in shape, and having the following courses and distances, to wit:-
