WHEREAS, Mrs. Pearl S. Williams has agreed to sell us the premises in the City of Greenville, South Carolina, known as 105 Gower Street in the present numbering of said City, for the sum of Six Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars (\$6,900.00), and has agreed to accept a down payment of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), and has agreed to take a purchase money mortgage for the balance of Six Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$6,400.00) payable in monthly installments of Sixty-six and 35/100 Dollars (\$66.35) each, with interest thereon at six (6%) per cent per annum, payable annually, until paid in full, with the right to anticipate payment in whole or in part on any monthly payment date, conditioned upon our paying her the full sum of a settlement due to us for the wrongful death of our son, Edward Perrin, Jr., upon the receipt thereof immediately by us, to be credited on said purchase money mortgage,

NOW KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That in consideration of the said Mrs. Pearl S. Williams conveying us the said premises known as 105 Gower Street, Greenville, South Carolina, for Six Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars (\$6,900.00) payable \$500.00 cash and a mortgage for \$6,400.00 payable in monthly installments of \$66.35 each beginning April 3, 1967, with interest thereon at 6% per annum, payable annually, until paid in full, with the right to anticipate payment in whole or in part on any monthly payment date, we <sup>Edward Perrin and Louise Perrin</sup> agree to pay to Mrs. Pearl S. Williams, her heirs or assigns, the full sum of a settlement due to us for the wrongful death of our son, Edward Perrin, Jr., immediately upon the receipt of said sum by us, the said sum to be credited by Mrs. Pearl S. Williams on said purchase money mortgage when received by her.
