KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, Eugene Perrit Willimon and Henry Pack Willimon, individually and as trustees under the Will of William Henry Willimon, deceased; and Alice Willimon von Stein; Ann Willimon Dixon; Harriet Willimon Cabell; R. C. Willimon, Jr.; and William H. Willimon, II in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and partial distribution of trust, to the grantors in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Charles P. Willimon, his heirs and assigns forever:

ALL that tract of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, containing 10.4 acres, more or less, lying on the southwestern side of Fork Shoals Road, and being shown on a plat entitled Property of Charles P. Willimon, made by Ethan C. Allen, R.L.S., November 6, 1965, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at a pin in the center of the Fork Shoals Road and running S. 25-44 E. 250.9 feet to an iron pin in the center of said road; thence with the center of said road S. 33-49 E. 482.9 feet to an iron pin on line of C. C. Coker; thence with Coker S. 58-20 W. 634.4 feet to an iron pin on line of Sammie K. Willimon; thence with that line N. 44-30 W. 580 feet to an iron pin on the line of other property of the Estate of W. H. Willimon; thence with the line of that estate N. 46-08 E. 793 feet to the point of beginning.

This is a portion of the property devised by William Henry Willimon by his Will which is of record in the Office of the Probate Judge for Greenville County in Apartment 531, File 13. It is the intention of this deed to dissolve the trust created by the Will of the said William Henry Willimon in this property,
