All that piece, parcel or lot of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in Paris Mountain Township, situate on Motor Boat Club Road and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on Motor Boat Club Road at the joint front corner of property of B. T. Whitmire's estate and property of Ed. Robinson's Estate and running thence along the joint line of said properties S. 6-30 W. 229.7 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 48-17 E. 79.7 feet to a County Road now or formerly known as Club Circle Drive; thence along the line of said County Road N. 0-55 E. 60 feet to a point; thence continuing along the line of said road N. 23-50 W. 123.8 feet to an iron pin at the intersection of Motor Boat Club Road and said County Road; thence along the line of Motor Boat Club Road N. 75-0 W. 78.7 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.
