If _____ should die while serving as my attorney-in-fact or should fail or refuse to accept this appointment for any reason, I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint _____ my attorney-in-fact in _____ stead with all the powers and duties hereinabove set forth to be enjoyed or performed by my attorney-in-fact herein named.

This Power of Attorney shall be revoked by death or revocation by me in writing.
