in consideration of TWENTY-SIX THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED AND No/100 (\$26,200.00)---Dollars,

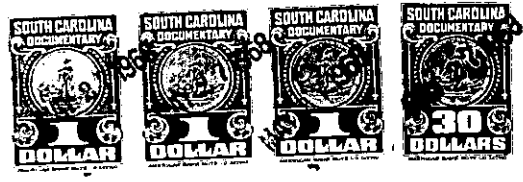
