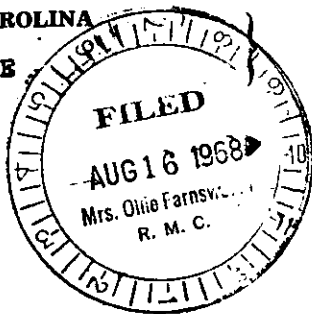

Taylor Street and running thence S 77° 45' W to the ^{172 feet} southeast corner
of the intersection of Adams and Taylor Streets; thence with the
east side of Adams Street S 12° 15' E 130 feet to an iron pin;
