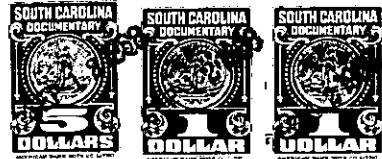

and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said THE CHURCH OF OUR LORD
AND SAVIOUR JESUS CHRIST OF THE APOSTOLIC FAITH, a South Carolina
Corporation,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, state
of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 5 on plat of
property of Ellison G. Webster, Jr. made by W. J. Riddle, May 1947
recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in plat book
O page 43, said lot having according to said plat the following metes
and bounds, courses and distances to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the south side of Anderson Road, the joint
front corner of Lots Nos. 5 and 6, which pin is 232 feet N. 56-10 E.
from a creek that crosses Anderson Road, and running thence with the
south side of Anderson Road N. 56-10 E. 14.8 feet; thence N. 63-05 E.
43.2 feet; thence S. 22-30 E. 100 feet; thence S. 63-05 W. 24 feet;
thence S. 56-10 W. 34 feet; thence N 22-40 W. 102 feet to the
beginning. This being the same lot conveyed to the grantor by Ellison
G. Webster, Jr. by deed dated Nov. 30, 1948 recorded in deed vol. 366
at page 207 of the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C.
