AMENDMENT TO RIGHT OF WAY AGREEMENT  
R. M. C.  
STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA  
COUNTY OF GREENVILLE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That

WHEREAS, by Right of Way Agreement executed by Clyde D. Jenkins dated June 30, 1949, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office in and for said County, in Book 388, Page 129 (hereinafter referred to as Original Agreement), TRANSCONTINENTAL GAS PIPE LINE CORPORATION (hereinafter called Transcontinental), is the owner of a right of way and easement for pipe line purposes across the lands described therein situated in Greenville County, South Carolina, reference being here made to said Original Agreement and its record for a complete description of the lands involved and all other purposes; and

WHEREAS, Transcontinental has heretofore constructed four pipe lines across said lands in accordance with said Original Agreement and may in the future, from time to time, desire to construct additional pipe lines pursuant thereto, and Jenk's Inc. (hereinafter called Grantor), as the present owner of said lands has requested Transcontinental to enter into this agreement for the purpose of defining Transcontinental's right of way.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed by and between Transcontinental and Grantor that, insofar as the lands owned by Grantor are concerned, said Original Agreement shall be and is hereby amended as follows:

1. Transcontinental's right of way shall be 165 feet in width, lying 15 feet southeasterly and 150 feet northwesterly of the most southeasterly of Transcontinental's existing pipe lines (being the 42" in diameter pipe line constructed in the year 1967), (Sketch Attached).
2. Transcontinental shall have the right of ingress and egress over and across adjoining lands of owner, providing that the right of ingress and egress over the adjoining lands of the owner shall be and would be Limited to lands not to exceed 50 feet in width on either side of the right of way as herein amended.

For and in consideration of the premises, Grantor does hereby grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto Transcontinental, its successors and assigns, a right of way and easement in accordance with the terms and provisions of said
