

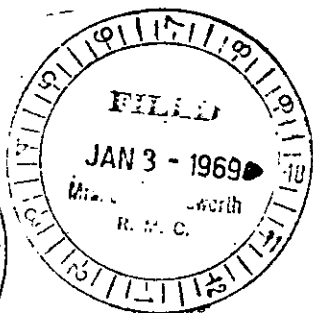
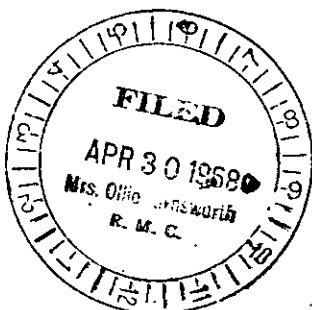

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with buildings and improvements thereon, near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the southern side of Central Court, being known and designated as Lot 53 of North Sunset Hills, recorded in Plat Book L at page 92, and according to said plat having the following metes and bounds, to wit:
