to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said grantee(s)

JOHN H. TAYLOR, JR., HIS HEIRS AND ASSIGNS, FOREVER:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on South Carolina Highway No. 106, being shown and designated as Lot No. 4, on plat of Section II, Belle Terre Acres, prepared by C. O. Riddle, RLS, July, 1964, and revised October, 1965, containing 2.14 acres, more or less, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the center line of South Carolina Highway No. 106, at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 4 and 5, and running thence S. 20-34 E. 377.5 feet to an iron pin; running thence S. 76-48 E. 290.1 feet to an iron pin; running thence along the line of Lot No. 3, N. 7-40 E. 384.2 feet to the center line of South Carolina Highway No. 106; thence with the center line of said Highway N. 81-41 W. 101 feet to a point; thence still with the center line of said Highway N. 76-31 W. 103.8 feet to the point of BEGINNING.

The within conveyance is subject to restrictions of record, and is also subject to utility easements and rights-of-way of record or on the ground.

As a part of the consideration, grantee assumes and agrees to pay the balance due on that certain mortgage from the grantors to Fidelity Federal Savings & Loan Association, Greenville, S. C., said mortgage being in the original amount of \$25,000.00, dated 5 July 1968, recorded 8 July 1968, RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Mortgage Book 1096, at Page 625.

The grantors hereby transfer and assign to grantee the insurance policy in connection with the above loan.
