



AMENDMENT TO RIGHT OF WAY AGREEMENT

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA  
COUNTY OF GREENVILLE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That

WHEREAS, by Right of Way Agreement executed by J. W. King, Sr., dated July 14, 1949, and recorded in Book 387, page 93, and by Right of Way Agreement executed by Galdys B. Barber dated July 14, 1949, recorded in Book 387, page 115, Deed Records for Greenville County, South Carolina (hereinafter referred to collectively as Original Agreement), TRANS-CONTINENTAL GAS PIPE LINE CORPORATION (hereinafter called Transcontinental) is the owner of a right of way and easement for pipe line purposes across the lands described therein situated in Greenville County, South Carolina, reference being here made to said Original Agreement and its record for a complete description of the lands involved and all other purposes; and

WHEREAS, Transcontinental has heretofore constructed four (4) pipe lines across said lands in accordance with said Original Agreement and may in the future from time to time, desire to construct additional pipe lines pursuant thereto, and J. P. Looper (hereinafter called Grantor) the present owner of said lands, has requested Transcontinental to enter into this agreement for the purpose of defining Transcontinental's right of way.

NOW THEREFORE, it is agreed by and between Transcontinental and Grantor that said Original Agreement shall be and is hereby amended as follows:

1. Transcontinental's permanent right of way shall be 150 feet in width, the side lines of same being located 10 feet southeasterly of and 140 feet northwesterly of and parallel to the centerline of Transcontinental's most southeasterly presently existing pipe line, being the 42 inch pipe line constructed in the year 1967. During periods of original construction of additional pipe lines Transcontinental shall have the right to clear and use, as temporary work space only, a strip of land 35 feet in width parallel to the northwesterly side of the right of way 150 feet as herein amended.
2. Grantor shall make no use of said 150 foot right of way which would affect or endanger Transcontinental's pipe lines or interfere with the construction of additional pipe lines.
