

to sell and transfer my interest in any automobile or other personal property to herself or to any other person and for that purpose to execute any bill of sale, assignments or transfers that may be required; and generally to do and perform all matters and things, transacting all business, make execute and acknowledge all contracts, orders, deeds, writings and instruments which may be requisite and proper to effectuate all or any of the premises or any other matter appertaining or belonging to me, with the same powers as I could personally; giving and granting unto my attorney full power to substitute one or more attorney or attorneys under her, in or concerning the premises, or any part thereof; my said attorney shall act in the exercise of all powers therein conferred, with the same authority as I could do if said powers were exercised by me personally and I hereby ratify and confirm whatsoever my attorney or her substitute or substitutes shall or may do by virtue of the premises.

I hereby revoke any and all power or powers of attorney heretofore executed by me.
