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FOURTH: The purpose of the said proposed Corporation ~~is~~ are exclusively, Religious, charitable, educational, and recreational; to conduct religious services, ceremonies, and schools; and to exercise certain moral and spiritual and charitable functions consistent with Christian Doctrine of the Baptist Discipline; and to cooperate with other groups with like concern. In the event of dissolution, the residual assets of this organization will be turned over to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt from Federal Income Tax as organizations described in Section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or the corresponding provisions of any prior or future Internal Revenue Code or to the Federal, State or Local Government for exclusively religious purposes.
