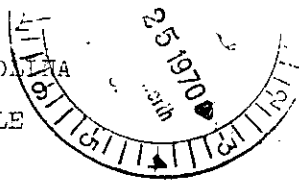

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that we, THE CITIZENS AND SOUTHERN NATIONAL BANK, PAUL K. PLUNKETT, as Successor Trustee to C. WESLEY KILLEBREW, and JAMES N. DORN, Successor Trustee to JOHN L. MURRAY, JR., all of Richmond County, Georgia, as Trustees for JOHN L. MURRAY, JR. under Trust agreement dated December 29, 1951, in consideration of the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars and other good and valuable consideration to them paid by JOHN L. MURRAY, JR. in the State aforesaid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell and release unto the said JOHN L. MURRAY, JR., his heirs and assigns,

A one-half undivided interest in and to all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about three miles Northeast from Greenville County Courthouse on the East side of Greenville-Greer National Highway and being known and designated as Lot No. 3, Map 1 of the Estate of Callie W. Raines, according to plat made by W. J. Middle in June 1947 and being recorded in Plat Book R, at page 25, REC Office for Greenville County and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at a point 161.5 feet East of the Camp Road and running thence South 50-10 East 175 feet to a point; thence South 20-32 West 75 feet to the joint corner of Lots 3 and 4; running thence along the joint line of Lots 3 and 4, North 50-18 West 175 feet to Lot No. 2; running thence along the line of Lots 2 and 3, 75 feet to the point of beginning.

Being the same property conveyed to the Grantors herein in Deed Book 837, page 432, REC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina. Said Trust Deed dated December 29, 1951, sets forth the authority of the Trust under which this Deed is executed.
