KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that We, Virgil D. Rupp and Helen V. Rupp

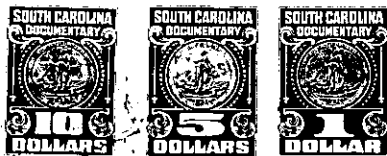
in consideration of Seven Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety-seven & 99/100 ----- Dollars,

Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Auburn Circle, joint front corner of Lots 115 and 116 and running thence with the joint line of said lots S. 14-43 E. 148.9 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 76-13 W. 75 feet to an iron pin in line of lot 114; thence with joint line of lots 114 & 115, N. 13-43 W. 149 feet to an iron pin on Auburn Circle; thence with the south side of Auburn Circle N. 76-17 E. 75 feet to the beginning corner.
