All that piece, parcel or lot of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being a portion of Lot No. 154 as shown on plat of Property of J. P. Rosemond, recorded in Plat Book H, at page 186, in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, said portion being shown on plat of Property of W. J. Fonville, prepared by Jones Engineering Service, on September 15, 1959, as revised on September 1, 1965, and having, according to the last mentioned plat, the following courses and distances, to wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the south side of Rodney Avenue, said point being N. 64-45 W. 133 feet from the intersection of Rodney Avenue and E. Decatur Street, and running thence from said point along Rodney Avenue N. 64-45 W. 93 feet to the corner of property heretofore conveyed to B. H. Trammell, et al., by deed recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 635, at page 329, said point being two feet from the west line of said Lot No. 154; running thence along property conveyed to Trammell, S. 27-55 W. 65.4 feet to an iron pin; running thence S. 64-45 E. 96 feet to a point; running thence N. 25-25 E. 65 feet to the point of beginning.
