unto Greenville County, its successors and assigns, forever:

All my undivided right, title, and interest in and to:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being located on the northerly side of McGee Street, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the easterly side of McGee Street and running thence N. 76-1/4 E. 171 feet to a point; thence N. 13 W. 70 feet to a point; thence S. 76-1/4 W. 180 feet to a point on McGee Street; thence with McGee Street in a southeasterly direction 70 feet to the beginning corner.
