KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Jane H. Richardson,

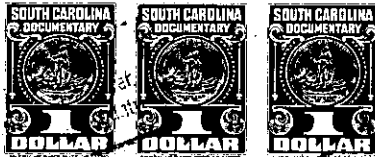
