TO HAVE AND TO HOLD said lot to said J. W. Spearman and his heirs and assigns forever, to be used for the interment of dead white persons only, and to be held, used, conveyed, devised or descend subject to the By-laws, Rules, and Regulations for the Cemetery of said church, at present of force or as hereafter amended or adopted and as may be shown by the minutes or other records of said Church.
